A part from the campaigns we have implemented 3 stages KA1 Erasmus+ project on the topic involving partners from 11 different countries.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Bulgaria is a non-profit youth organization, promoting volunteering and volunteer values around the country of Bulgaria. Main goals:

- To give young people the chance to consciously participate in their own growth as citizens and to take an active part in the development of society as a whole;
- To work for the advancement and institutionalization of the Big Brothers Big Sisters program around Bulgaria;
- To enrich the awareness of young people with regard to the possibilities of volunteer work, social entrepreneurship and active civic participation.

In the past 11 years we have focused our efforts in expanding the Big Brothers Big Sisters program around Bulgaria and in supporting greater number of vulnerable children and youth through one-to-one mentoring/volunteer relationships. The program has been functioning in 3 main directions (school-based, community-based and site-based) and has encompassed more than 500 mentees. The organization has a well established school network of 7 Preliminary and 13 secondary schools on the territory of Plovdiv region where it delivers mentoring services for vulnerable children. The community based direction of the program has been implemented in cooperation with the Pedagogy Department of the University of Plovdiv and most of the volunteer-mentors have been University students.

Our organization has been working in close relationship with the Bulgarian Fund for Women since 2009. As a result of this partnership a youth club for gender equality has been established from our volunteers in 2011. Since then the club has implemented a variety of projects and initiatives focusing on sex education, girls' rights, promotion of equality, etc. Except this initiative, we have developed and implemented Erasmus+ project in 2016 "Better Together" focusing on gender stereotypes, human rights and women empowerment on the Balkans.

implemented a KA1 Erasmus+ project in 2016 "Be Happy Be Healthy" with participants from 13 countries where we have promoted healthy living as an alternative against the social exclusion. A part from that, at our training activities we always try to use interactive methods, i.e. sports and other games and activities.

Our organization has been focusing vulnerable children and youth in particular which is a prerequisite for encouraging participation of Roma representatives as well as of other vulnerable groups in our programs and activities.

Some of the children involved in the Big Brothers Big Sister's mentoring program suffer from some physical or mental disabilities. These diseases usually stop them from visiting schools and from developing social skills and strong friendships. Coming to the organization they receive long-term mentor as well as memorable moments and quality time spent together with their bigger friend.

We have been involved in the national initiative of the Ministry of Youth and Sports "Say NO to the bullying" in 2016/2017 school year. As a local coordinator of this initiative around the area of Plovdiv we have organized more than 15 meetings in schools where our volunteers were talking with their peers about bullying, hate speech on-line and aggression among the pupils.

We are very limited in staff (just 4 people) , but quite large in relation to number of volunteers we work with (50-70 a year). That is why the organization is very open to ideas, suggestions and proposals from any person who is interested to take an action or initiative in order to contribute to the development of our mission and achieving our goals.

As we have mentioned, our organization is an youth NGO focusing on volunteer involvement. We work with approximately 50-70 volunteers a year, depending on our on-going projects. The majority of them is at the age 15-25 years. We involve our volunteers in all stages of implementing the projects - from the time of their application to the time of their implementation and reporting. Young people's opinion has always being important

to us and we always encouraged our members to speak up and share. Since 2014 we have been partnering in a project of IDEA (Netherlands) for encouraging debating education in the neighborhood, where we teach young people coming from disadvantaged background to debate and share their opinion with the authorities.
